Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Routes Around School from 4th November 2013

As I have previously informed you, we have a Pre-Start Meeting with Ashe Construction on Thursday 3rd October. Ashe Construction are the contractors who will be undertaking the expansion work on our school. From the 14th October works will start on the school site to what will be the Temporary Office from after half-term.

On the reverse of this letter is a map of the school site identifying the site compound and the constraints on movement around the site.

As you will appreciate, any building or major construction work on a school site will inevitably have an impact on movement. I hope that this map and information will help to make life easier for you and your children. You can rest assured that while this work is taking place, your child's education will only be enhanced as we will certainly take advantage of the project/topic work that can be generated from such an event in the school's life.

For your information: The main headline to this information is that there will be **no path across the front of the school (i.e. Valley Road side) as identified by the green hatched area on the map.**

Rising Stars children: you will be able to access the school in the usual way. There will be a new fence at the top of the main school path and an adjoining path for you to access Rising Stars. Collection will be the same.

Nursery children: you will be able to access the Nursery from the Grange Road Entrance; please use the gate and path outside the After School Club building and make your way to the Nursery Outside area using the paths. Collection will be the same.

Reception and Year 1 children: you will be able to access the Key Stage 1 playground as before although there will be no access from Reception outdoor area. If you have a child in Nursery and Reception or Years 1 or 2, you will need to go back out of the Grange Road entrance, turn right and go around the playground using the path. Reception children can be collected from outside their classrooms as before (see map); Year 1 children will be collected from the playground. This change will hopefully ease congestion. If you are collecting children from Reception and Year 1, I'm sure staff will more than happily assist in making that easier for you.

Year 2-Year 6 children: you will only be able to access your child's class from the Key Stage 2 Playgrounds. There will be no access from the Grange Road entrance unless you take the path that follows the playground and brings you round to the Car Park. Children can be collected from their classes as usual.

As always, please feel free to get in touch if you have any particular access or collection issues with these changes; we are more than happy to work with you to make this whole process as easy as possible.
